- 2 The figures for the quarter ended 31st March, 2020 are the balancing figures between the audited figures in respect of the full financial year and the unaudited published figures upto nine months of the relevant financial year.
- 3 As required under Regulation 33 of SEBI(Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations,2015, the Statutory Auditors have conducted a limited review of the above results for the quarter ended 30th June,2020
- 4 This statement has been prepared in accordance with the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 (Ind AS), as amended, prescribed under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 and other recognised accounting practices and policies to the extent applicable.
- 5 The Consolidated financial result includes financial results of subsidiary Company namely Synergy Films Pvt. Ltd.
- 6 The Company had closed its manufacturing plant and office with effect from March 24, 2020 following countrywide lockdown due to Covid- 19. The Company has gradually commenced operations from April 18, 2020 after obtaining necessary approvals. The Company's operations were impacted in the quarter, due to scaling down/suspending production due to supply chain constraints, shortage of workforce and with a view to ensure safety across all areas of operations. The Company has assessed the impact of Covid-19 pandemic on its business operations and has considered relevant internal and external information available up to the date of approval of these results, in determination of the recoverability and carrying value of property, plant and equipment, inventories, and trade receivables. Based on current estimates, the Company expects the carrying amount of these assets will be recovered. The Company will continue to closely monitor any material changes to future economic conditions.
- 7 Provision for taxes, employment benefits and other provisions for contingencies have been considered on estimated basis
- 8 The Company is engaged in only one segment and as such there is no separate reportable segment as per Ind AS 108: 'Operating Segments'
- 9 Previous period figures have been regrouped/rearranged wherever necessary.
