Weeks after resigning for 'time with kids', Surat Dy municipal chief makes U-turn

Swati Desai, first woman to hold the post, says she changed her mind after talks with family members

WEEKS AFTER resigning from her job citing "lack of time to spend with her kids", Surat Municipal Corporation (SMC) deputy commissioner Swati Desai has decided to withdraw her resignation.

Her resignation letter was in the process of being cleared, in a month from the time of submission, as per the rule.

Desai, 43, who rose from the ranks of a clerk to be deputy municipal commissioner in charge of Udhna zone, had resigned after working over 20 years in the SMC stating that her "tough work schedule" meant she was not getting enough time with her 11-year-old twin boys.

Desai, who is the first woman to hold the post, has 15 years of service left.

While resigning early this month, she informed Municipal Commissioner M Nagarajan that she wanted to spend time with her children "who are growing up and whose school grades are going down", but on Saturday (February 21) she wrote another letter to the Commissioner seeking to withdraw it. Hailing from a wealthy landlord family in Antroli village in Surat district, Desai had told The Indian Express that after her resignation she got "seven job offers from private firms".

She had asked the com-

panies to wait as her decision would have to be ratified by the standing committee and the general board of the SMC.

After receiving the resignation letter, Nagarajan had urged her to reconsider it and not to take a "hasty decision".

Nagarajan told The Indian Express, "First we got the resignation letter from Swati Desai, and on Saturday we received a letter seeking to withdraw the earlier resignation letter. Generally, in such cases wherein an officer hands over the resignation letter to us, we have one month to decide. Later, the process is carried out. I have told Swati Desai that she should think twice while taking such an important decision. She is a regular, honest, and hardworking officer, and to date, there is no complaint against her."

Desai said she changed her decision after speaking to "near and dear ones." "I resigned to spend time with my children. However, after holding discussions with family members, relatives and in-laws, I have decided to withdraw my resignation letter, and I acted on it," Desai said.

Desai joined the SMC as a clerk in the accounts department in 2007, and she was appointed as municipal secretary in 2017. She became the first female municipal secretary—also the youngest—of the SMC at the age of 32. In 2021, she was promoted and appointed as deputy municipal commissioner.

FINAL PHASE OF DEMOLITION DRIVE TODAY

On Day Two, Rajkot civic body razes 367 more 'illegal' structures

Scope expanded from original target of 1,489 properties to 1,509: Officials

THE RAJKOT Municipal Corporation (RMC) on Tuesday continued its drive to demolish a large swathe of "illegal" encroachments on the Aji riverbed and the adjoining road, clearing 367 properties. This is in addition to the 1,119 properties that were completely or partially demolished on Monday, when the drive began.

With 1,486 of the properties across a 4.6-km area of Jangleshwar area of Rajkot city having been demolished after eviction of occupants, the remaining properties will be demolished on Wednesday morning, officials said.

The scope of the drive has also been expanded from an original target of 1,489 properties to 1,509 structures.

At the end of the second day of the drive at 6 pm on Tuesday, this still left 23 properties to be demolished.

However, herein lies the tricky part of the operation. These 23 properties are located adjacent to another 900-odd properties that were also to be demolished but that action has been stayed by the Gujarat High Court, leaving the RMC with the task of surgically demolishing these two-dozen odd properties while making sure that there is no damage to the properties under protection of the judiciary.

Rajkot Municipal Commissioner Tushar Sumera told The Indian Express, "There are now only 23 properties left to be demolished. This will be carried out carefully as these structures are adjoining about 900 prop-

erties which are on land under the jurisdiction of the Collectorate and on which there is a stay order."

Speaking about the demolitions from Gandhinagar, MLA Amit Chavda, President of the Gujarat Pradesh Congress Committee, said, "The face of the BJP's double engine sarkar has been exposed once more. This is a government that is razing the homes of the poor with bulldozers but is helpless against industrialists. In reply to the question regarding land encroachment, the government has said that in Hazira, the Arcelor Mittal Steel India company has encroached upon 173 hectares of government land.

And this is not the first time, the government puts in on record year after year that this company has encroached on some land for the last 38 years, on others for 36 years, 33 years and 20 years. The government admits this but is unable to vacate it. The bulldozer doesn't move there."

He added, "But in Rajkot, yesterday bulldozers ran over the homes of the poor, and before that, on the homes of the Thakore, Rabari, Dalit, OBC, minority communities in Ahmedabad. Bulldozers are being used in Ambaji, Somnath, Veraval, in Dwarka, in the temples, on people's homes, but this double engine sarkar does not have the courage to set its bulldozers on the 30-year-old illegal encroachment of one company."

Chavda added, "This government says Sab ka saath, sab ka vikas, but after getting sab ka saath (support), their helplessness against these corpor-

ates shows that this government is against the poor and is helpless before industrialists. It is clear that "sab ka saath, sab ka vikas" is just a slogan."

The Rajkot city administration plans to build an Aji Riverfront along the lines of the Sabarmati riverfront in Ahmedabad but the stated

goal of the demolitions is to avoid flooding in this area by removing encroachments and allowing the flow of rainwater.

Union Cabinet nod for extension of Metro Rail Corridor from GIFT City to Shahpur

THE UNION Cabinet on Tuesday approved the extension of the Metro corridor between Ahmedabad and GIFT City at a cost of Rs 1,067.35 crore.

In a statement, the government said the Cabinet, chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, approved the Gujarat Metro Rail Corporation's extension of the North-South corridor from GIFT City to Shahpur. With three elevated stations, the new corridor will cover 3.33 km and take about four years to complete, it said.

"This extended corridor is expected to benefit approximately 23,702 passengers in 2029 and approximately 58,059 passengers in 2041. This corridor will strengthen connectivity between Ahmedabad and GIFT region. Major multinational companies, educational institutions, and commercial centers located along the proposed route will directly benefit," the statement said.

It added that the project was likely to create around 1,000 jobs in the construction phase and another 250 post construction in the form of operations and maintenance.

"This project will generate a significant number of direct employment opportunities, equivalent to the number mentioned above. Additionally, other activities will generate indirect employment for even more people," it said.

As of now, the Gujarat Metro Rail Corporation has a network of 68.28 km, with a daily ridership of 1.60 lakh.

With this approval of the Union Cabinet the 3.33-kilometre-long extension from GIFT City to Shahpur will include three elevated stations. The project is estimated at approximately Rs 1,067.35 crore.
