PILGRIMS WERE ON THEIR WAY TO KALIKA MATA TEMPLE

2 killed, 5 injured after rockfall at Pavagadh hill

Vadodra, June 19

TWO PILGRIMS were killed and five others injured in Gujarat after a massive rockfall, triggered by heavy rainfall, struck a pilgrimage route near Patiya-pul on Pavagadh Hill early on Friday.

According to officials, the landslide took place around 6 am when large boulders rolled down near Patiya-pul, trapping several pilgrims who had arrived early for worship at the Kalika Mata temple.

The police said that the primary cause of the accident seems to be soil erosion and the sudden collapse of large rocks from the hillside, as the area has been receiving heavy rain for the past few days, resulting in the landslide.

Rescue teams from the ropeway service at Pavagadh rushed to the site immediately and retrieved two bodies. The deceased have been identified as Pranavsinh Parmar (52), and Gunwantsingh Parmar (40) —

both residents of Lalupura in Kathlal of Kheda district. The injured have been identified as Prithviraj Dabhi (28) and Maganbhai Dabhi (48), both residents of Ahmedabad as well as Jay Kumbhadia (16) and Jayesh Dhanji (31) — from Katargam in Surat. The five injured people have sustained multiple fractures, the police said. The injured were provided emergency medical assistance and transported by 108 ambulance services to the Government

Hospital in Halol for treatment. The local police and Fire and Rescue Services Department, as well as the village sarpanch, joined the rescue efforts and co-ordinated with emergency responders at the scene. Officers of the Pavagadh police station also reached the location to assist in rescue operations and manage the situation. The police said that the bodies of the two pilgrims have been sent for post-mortem.

The incident has raised con-

cerns about visitor safety arrangements in the Pavagadh hill area, particularly with the onset of the monsoon. The pilgrimage destination at the summit of Pavagadh hill sees lakhs of devotees arriving on important ritualistic days of the month, in all seasons. Kalika Mata Temple is situated at a height of 822 meters on Pavagadh Hill in Panchmahal district. Some pilgrims opt for cable cars while others choose to climb 2,000 steps to reach the temple.

In Surat, widow's body lies unclaimed, her toddler in shelter as families refuse custody

TWO DAYS after a young widow died allegedly by suicide in Surat, her body remains unclaimed at a hospital mortuary Friday, while her two-year-old daughter has been placed in a shelter home after both her maternal and paternal families allegedly refused to take responsibility for them.

According to the Surat police, Reena, 22, a resident of Bhavnagar district, married Akshay Baraiya about three years ago against her family's wishes. The inter-caste marriage reportedly led both families to sever ties with the couple, who lived in a rented house in Bhavnagar and later had a daughter.

"We are continuously putting our efforts to convince Reena's parents and her brother-in-law," H B Patel, Inspector, Ashwani Kumar Police Station, told *The Indian Express*.

"We will have to keep the body for seven days, and if no-

body turns up to claim the body, it will be cremated. The minor is presently in Katargam Bal Ashram, and the staffers are taking good care of her," Patel added.

The police said that, as per procedure, if the minor's grandfather or uncle wishes to claim custody of the child, they must file an application with the Child Welfare Committee (CWC), which will decide to whom the child's custody should be granted.

A plea for help

The police said Akshay, who suffered from kidney-related ailments, died four months ago, leaving Reena to raise her child alone. Investigators said she survived on limited savings after her husband's death and received no support from either side of the family.

Officers at the Ashwini Kumar Police Station said Reena had approached her parents after Akshay's death, but they refused to accept her or her daughter. She later sought help

from her late husband's elder brother, who also declined to support them, the police said.

On June 15, Reena travelled to Surat with her daughter and checked into Umiya Mata Alithi Gruh, a community guest house in the Varachha area. According to the police, she spent the night there before allegedly dying by suicide the following day.

The last call

Before that, investigators said Reena called her father from the reception area of the guest house to inform him about her condition and the whereabouts of her daughter. Citing the manager, who was present in the reception area when Reena called her father, they said her father disconnected the call.

Guest house staff then alerted trustees and rushed her to the Surat Municipal Corporation-run SMIMER Hospital, where she was declared dead on June 17. The police went to the hospital after learning about the incident and collected primary details. They also went to the guest house, spoke with the manager, and obtained her father's number.

The police subsequently contacted both Reena's father and her brother-in-law, informing them of her death and requesting them to claim the body and take custody of the child. However, both allegedly refused. With no family member coming forward, the police placed the two-year-old girl at the Katargam Bal Ashram.

State doing well for lion conservation: Union minister

UNION ENVIRONMENT and Forest Minister Bhupender Yadav on Friday said the Gujarat government has undertaken measures for conservation of Asiatic lions and has been addressing challenges related to their protection with sensitivity and commitment.

His comments came in the backdrop of deaths of eight Asiatic lion cubs in Gujarat's Gir forest region in May.

Speaking on the sidelines of the 'Viksit Bharat Sankalp Sammelan' in Gandhinagar, Yadav said he was in contact with Gujarat Forest Minister Arjun Modhwadia regarding lion conservation issues.

"I assure you that the Gujarat government is working well to conserve lions and all challenges, including diseases, are being handled sensitively," Yadav said. "I am in contact with Forest Minister Arjun Modhwadia, he has been reviewing the situation. I also recently visited Gir. Local causes (of lion deaths) are also being identified and a significant amount of control has been established," he added.

3 injured as gas cylinders explode at Ahmedabad distribution agency

AT LEAST three persons were injured after three gas cylinders exploded leading to a fire at a distribution agency in the Gitamandir area of Ahmedabad on Friday, officials said.

The injured, identified as Aakash Bhavsar (owner), Abdul Kader Kureshi, and Mohammad Firoz Bhatti, were inside the premises at the time of the explosion and fire. They were rescued and shifted to hospital by firefighters.

The blaze was brought under control after an over three-hour operation by firefighters, officials said.

The Ahmedabad Fire and Emergency Services (AFES) control room received a call at



4:41 pm that a gas agency situated opposite Aarogya Bhavan in Gitamandir area caught fire and that multiple blasts had occurred there. The Aarogya Bhavan is the Ahmedabad Munici-

pal Corporation's health department office.

Fire Station Officer (STO) Raturaj Gadhvi said that 10-12 vehicles were pressed into service during the over 3-hour operation, led by Chief Fire Officer (CFO) Amit Dongre.

Officials said that three cylinders exploded and 10-12 others had allegedly developed leaks. Firefighters, while dousing the flames, also had to segregate the leaking gas cylinders, hand them over to the respective company officials and conduct continuous cooling operations, thereby avoiding a bigger tragedy. The source of the explosion and subsequent fire is under investigation. The Mayor and top AMC officials visited the spot on Friday evening.
